We struggle

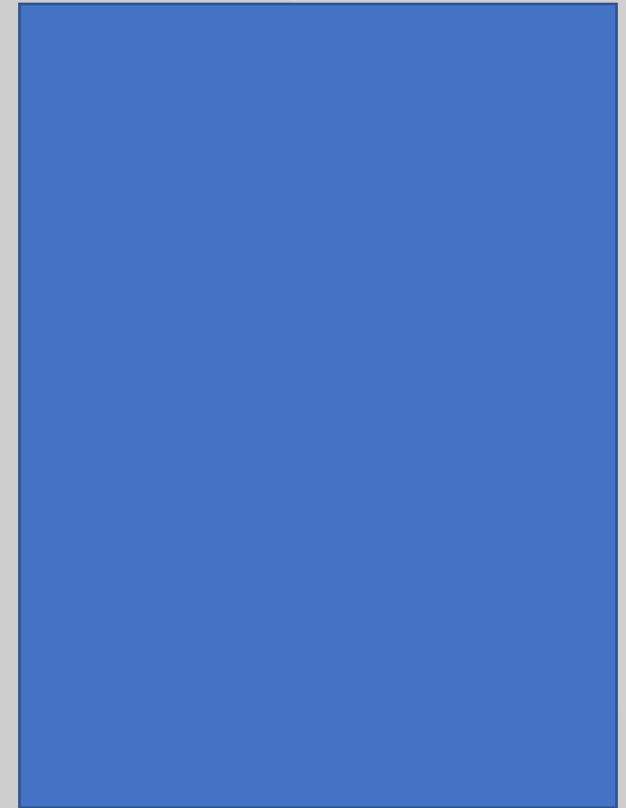
Surely God is good to Israel,

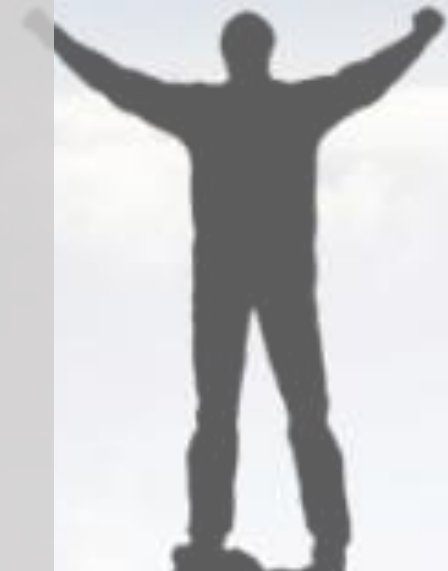

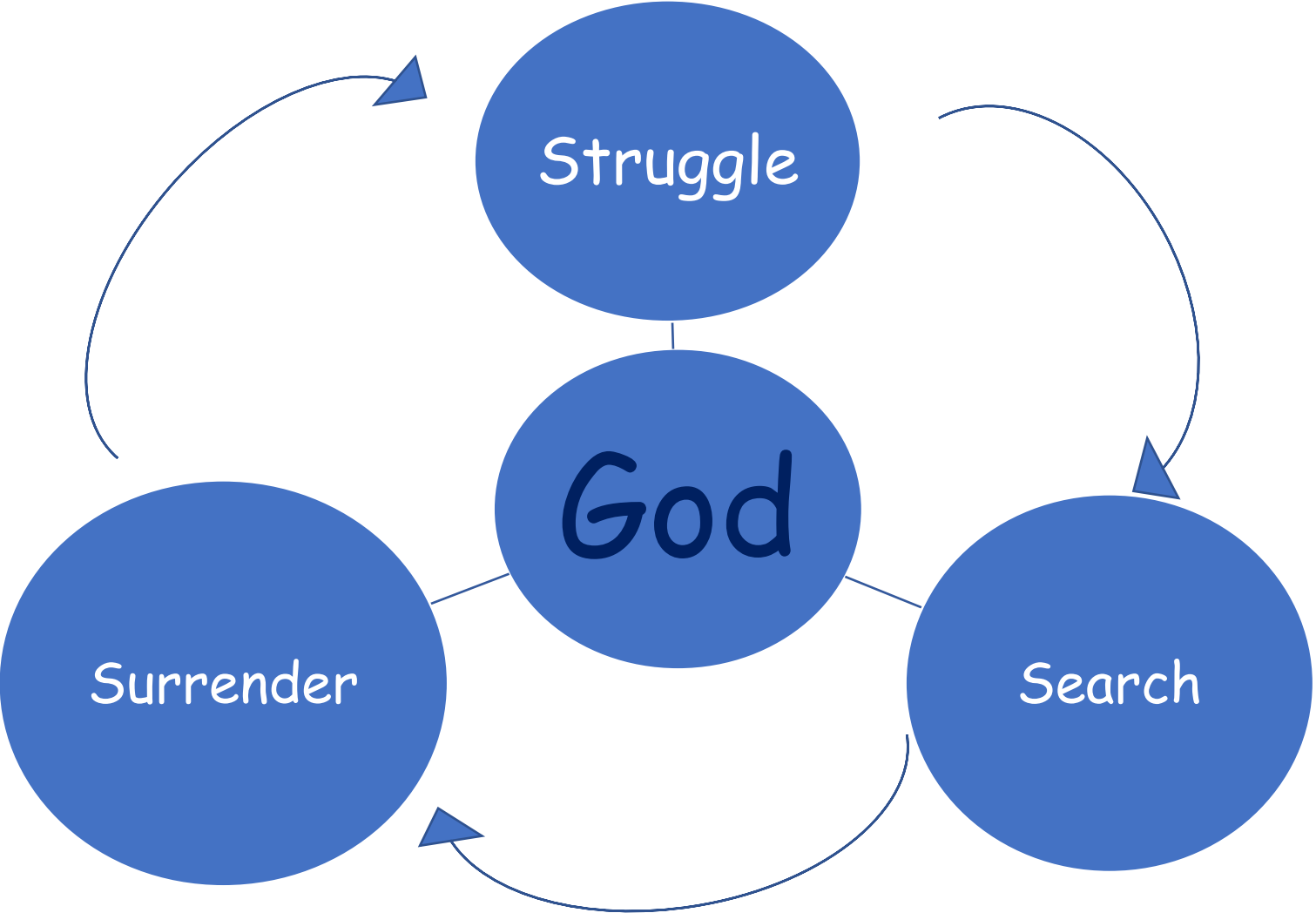


We Surrender
